SCV Search & Rescue Team Trail Challenge

January 30 – April 18

SCV Search & Rescue, a local volunteer team that works under the direction of the SCV Sheriff's Dept. chose some of our favorite local SCV trails to create a fun and fitness adult challenge for you, your friends, and co-workers. Over a 12-week period you will be challenged to complete a minimum of 10 local hikes. (If you prefer you can do more than 1 hike per week, and miss other weeks and still meet the challenge).

The challenge has both a long distance challenge where challengers track their miles and different trails, and the hike challenge where participation alone is acknowledged. The event is both a challenge to do the hikes and an opportunity to familiarize our challengers with many of the great hiking opportunities in Santa Clarita. Tracking of your individual accomplishments is on the honor system, and can be achieved either through individual hikes or participation in some of the team or corporate sponsored hikes. The hikes vary between 2-9 miles. Many hikes can be shortened by turning back prior to the turnaround points

Finish time is not a factor, accomplishing the hikes and having a fun time is the objective. Many of the hikes are out and back hikes, so it is easy to convert a longer hike into a shorter hike for weather or personal choice.

The event specifics:

Individual Participants:

Donation: \$50 Your contribution is a fully tax deductible donation to your local Search & Rescue Team, and will support team equip. and training expenditures in 2010. You will receive an SCV Search & Rescue 2010 Trail Challenge T-Shirt, enjoy the challenge of exploring several local trails, and the ability to coordinate your hiking with other participants, including members of our SCV Search & Rescue Team.

The trail challenge will kick off at the picnic grounds at **Ed Davis Park in Towsley Canyon** on Saturday January 30th between 8:00 – 10:00 with registration and the first challenge hike. Over the next several weeks participants will complete their challenge hikes. The Trail challenge will end on April 18th with a BBQ and

awards ceremony hosted by the SCV Search and Rescue Team and sponsors of the event (location and time to be announced).

Corporate Sponsorship Challenge:

Donation of \$250 for the sponsorship, and \$50 per participant. In addition to the individual awards for Corporate team members completing the long distance challenge or general hike challenge, there will be a corporate award for which Corporate Sponsor can log the most overall miles and which has the highest average miles per participant.

* Hikers, based on ability, can choose to substitute either the longer hikes or shorter hikes with the opposite to either lighten or add to the challenge. Also, on out-and-back hikes, hikers should gage their actual “out” distance based on their personal hiking skill.

* All participants will receive a trail brochure that details trail heads, parking areas, mileage estimates, and brief trail descriptions. In addition, over the course of the 3-months, 2-3 schedules will be e-mailed out detailing the trails that SCV Search & Rescue Members will be leading, and also the details regarding the time and location of the final BBQ and awards presentations.

* During the course of the challenge other hikes may be offered on a guided basis only. These will be offered via e-mail.
